MEP Auken returns to the Costa

THE AUN association is hosting an open meeting on Saturday, September 26 to inform residents on issues surrounding Valencia land-grab laws and the national coastal law.

Special guests include MEP Margrete Auken who presented the damning report on development abuses in Spain to the EU parliament earlier this year.

She will speak on the future of urban development in the Valencia Region and how this will affect local people.

Alicante university professor Jorge Olcina, a specialist in sustainable urban development, will talk on experiences and practices for a sustainable development of the territory.

Carmen del Amo, president of the European Association of Property Owners affected by the Coast Law, will also give a presentation.

After the meeting there will be an opportunity for those attending to speak with the experts.

The meeting runs from 18.00 until 20.00 at the Hotel Sun Palace on Calle Hércules in Albir.

A spokesman for the AUN association, which fights developments abuses in the Valencia Region, said they had prepared the conference to turn the spotlight on land grab and other abusive urban development practices.
